

TO THE BUS DRIVER

Thank you for bringing the students safely to the New Bedford Whaling Museum. While you are here, you are welcome to visit the Museum as our guest.

New Bedford is located 1 hour south of Boston, MA and 45 minutes east of Providence, RI

- From I-195, take **Exit 15** (New Bedford Downtown).
- Proceed one mile to the first set of lights (**Elm Street**) and turn right.
- Take your first left onto **North Water Street** and proceed one block to the corner of **Water and William Streets** (this is the back of the Museum). Students may disembark the bus by the Whale's Tail sculpture. Teachers and Chaperones are asked to escort students to the front entrance of the Museum.
- Proceed straight ahead to **Union Street**.
- Turn left onto **Union Street**.
- Proceed along Union Street, through the intersection with Route 18 to **State Pier**. Bus parking spots are located on the Northwest (street) side of the attendant booth at State Pier.

TO RETURN TO THE MUSEUM FROM STATE PIER

- From the State Pier parking lot cross **MacArthur Drive** and turn right onto **Route 18**.
- At **Elm Street** (1st light) turn left and take the first left onto **North Water Street**.
- Students may be picked up at the corner of **Water and William Streets** (by the Whale's Tail sculpture).

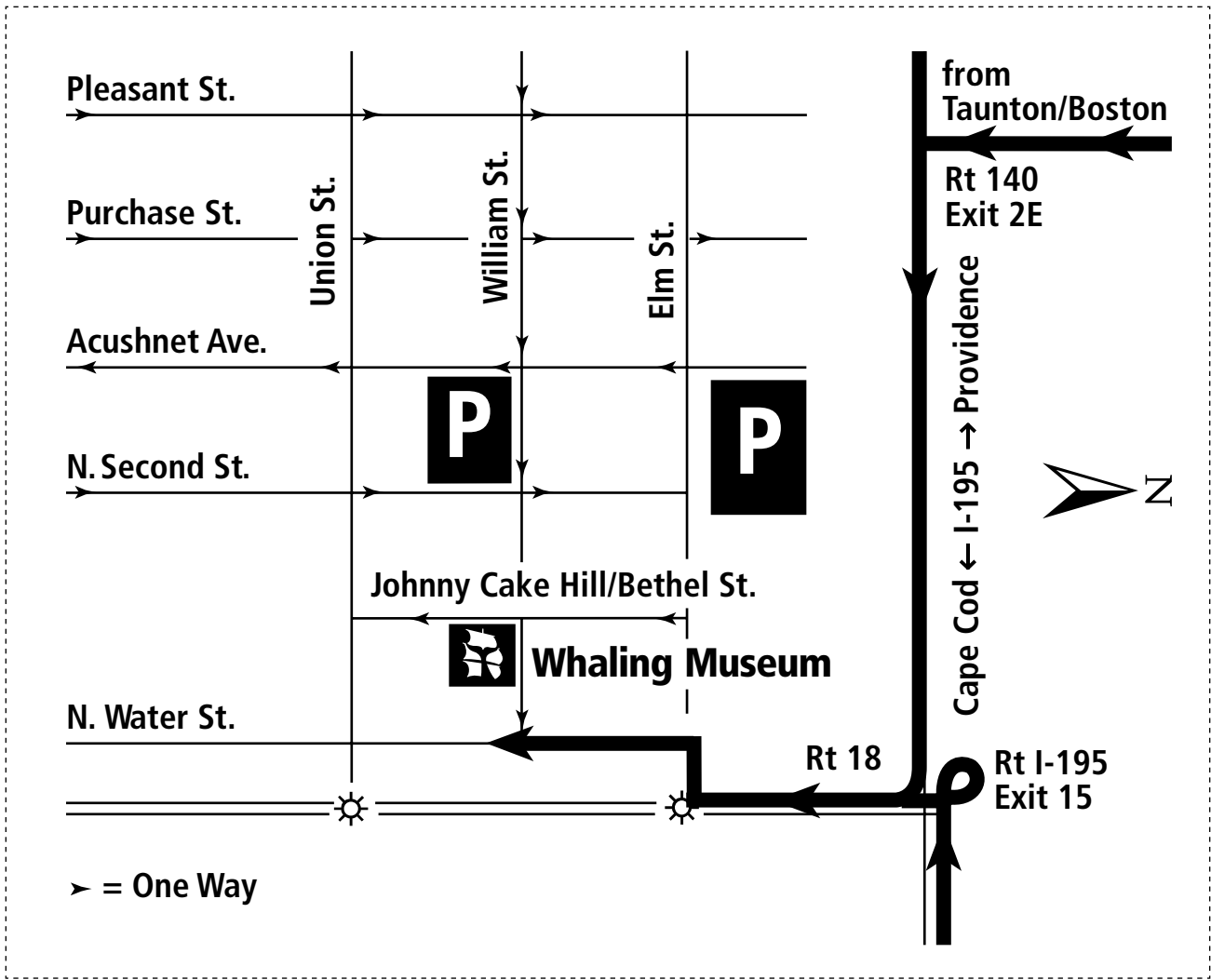
Street map of New Bedford on reverse side
