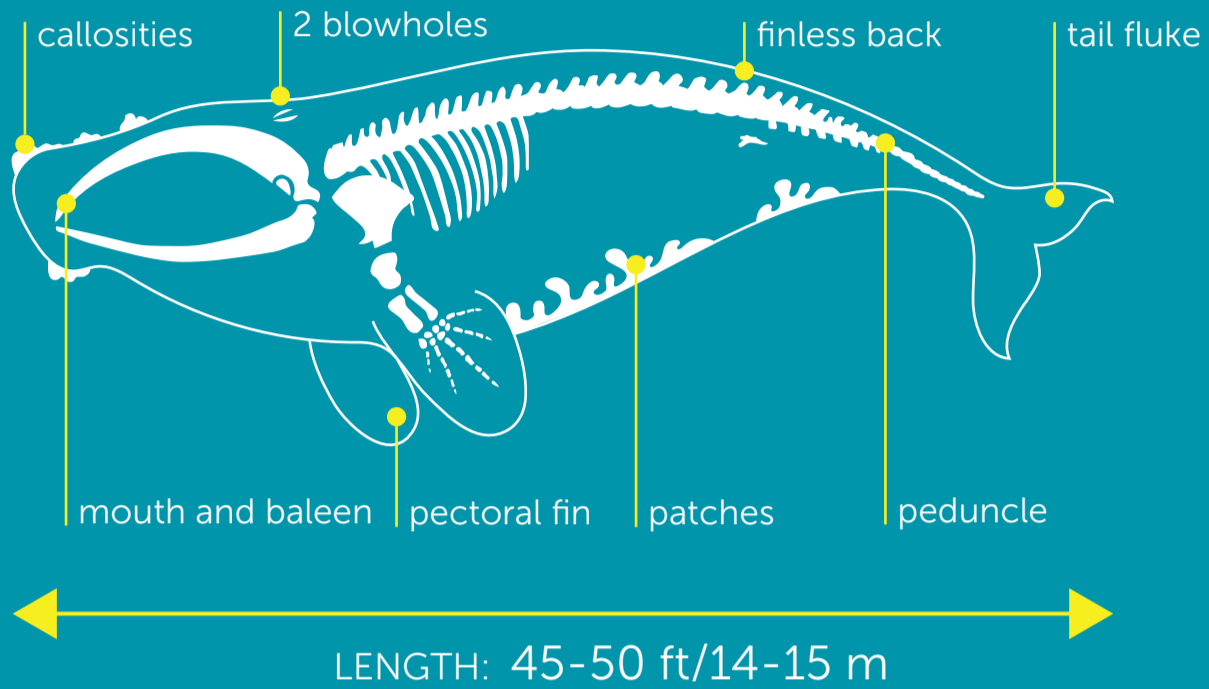


# NORTH ATLANTIC RIGHT WHALE

adults eat more than a billion tiny zooplankton called copepods per day

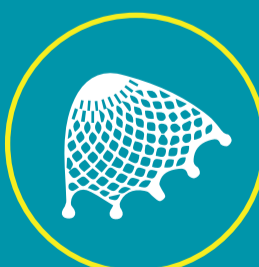


identify individuals by callosity patterns on their heads
