Questions about Extended Learning Programs for All Groups

Enhance your visit with these additional opportunities. Please note that these options may have limited availability.

25. Are you interested in seeing the 3D movie?

The Museum shows ocean-themed 3D movies in the theater. School groups can reserve tickets to see this 30-minute-long film for \$4 per person (including teachers and chaperones) for a regularly scheduled movie. 26. Are you interested in doing a Squid Dissection lab?

In this 45 minute-long hands-on program, students learn to dissect a squid. Recommended for grades 3 and up. There is an additional fee of \$7 per student. All groups will be charged for a minimum of 15 students. Groups larger than 25 students will be split into multiple sections.

27. Are you interested in the STEM Design Challenge activity?

In this 45 minute-long hands-on program, students will design mitigation strategies for sea level rise. There is an additional fee of \$7 per student. All groups will be charged for a minimum of 15 students. Groups larger than 25 students will be split into multiple sections.

28. Are you interested in going inside an inflatable humpback whale?

Groups can schedule time to climb inside an inflatable whale that is only available at select times. There is an additional fee of \$250 per group with no group maximum. Time slots will be scheduled in 60-minute increments. The inflatable whale is not accessible for some students with mobility needs.

Groups can schedule time to explore an additional section of the *Lagoda* whaling ship that is usually closed to the public. There is an additional fee of \$50 per group of 50 students. Larger groups will be scheduled and charged for additional time slots. Time slots will be scheduled in 30-minute increments. This space is not accessible for some students with mobility needs.

Curators can lead a tour of a special exhibit or talk with students about their work. Recommended for high school or college students. Curator visits usually last 60 minutes. There is an additional fee of \$7 per student. All groups will be charged for a minimum of 15 students. Groups larger than 30 will be split into multiple groups.

Groups can visit the Research Room to explore primary sources related to a topic you are studying in class. Recommended for middle school, high school, or college students. Research visits usually last 60 minutes. There is an additional fee of \$7 per student. All groups will be charged for a minimum of 15 students. Groups larger than 20 students will be split into multiple groups.
